Forum to Engage Men (FEM) Jharkhand

FEM Jharkhand is an alliance of 16 organizations working on gender based violence, child rights and VAW issues in the state. These organizations are committed to reducing incidents of violence against women in their respective area. FEM Jharkhand raises awareness among community through different means and made a presence in the state. FEM Jharkhand is primarily active in 16 blocks of 10 districts of Jharkhand State.

Background

FEM Jharkhand started during 2012 when Dr. Kalyani Meena taken initiative on the call of Centre for Health and Social Justice, New Delhi to start a campaign on the issue of violence against women and child rights that these issues are not just a women's issue but an issue that involved society at large. In order to focus men's attention on the issues, and to build a larger coalition of concerned and active men, a series of meetings were held and the FEM campaign was launched in Jharkhand during December 2012. Male members and activists of 16 social development organizations have been the backbone of FEM Jharkhand, and starting from the meeting of partners on

December 2012, the message of FEM Jharkhand has now spread to 10 districts covering schools, colleges, universities, village communities, urban communities, farmers, businessmen, media from all sectors of society are associated with FEM Jharkhand. 16 Groups are now active in 10 districts of Jharkhand.

The group of 16 active organizations in the state collectively decided to be part of this process of father care campaign with the objective of understanding and addressing the issue of fatherhood and contribute towards strengthening the existing state network working with men. The group decided to name the network as "FEM Jharkhand", decided by all partner organizations and also suggested by Satish Ji from CHSJ. "FEM Jharkhand" works for involving men in society to be part of the process of addressing VAW, Gender equality and child rights in the state. The group believes that this campaign will be helpful in addressing VAW and ensuring Child rights in the state.

Geographical Outreach

At present FEM Jharkhand is directly working in 10 districts of Jharkhand. The all 24 districts of the state will be covered phase wise.

Vision

"FEM Jharkhand envisages a just society by focusing on empowerment of women creating space, opportunity and mitigating incidences of violence against women and ensuring child rights."

Objectives

- To reduce incidences of violence against women, gender inequality and ensuring child rights in the state with the involvement and active role of men.
- To develop women leadership and self confidence of women by the support of men in all sectors of society.
- To create awareness and sensitization of men on the factors responsible for poor status of women in the society and promoting action to address issues of discriminations and violence of women.
- To liaise and network building with like minded organizations working around larger women issues to raise issues from bigger platform
- To make advocacy effort for execution of various laws and policies to reduce incidences of VAW and also to ensure child rights.
