1.) Review plan of FEM Jharkhand 2013-14:-

The final approved plan of FEM Jharkhand presented before the house and activities discussed which is to be taken during this year 2013-14. Dr. Kalyani Meena will take appointment from CREA to meet and inform all other members of the team. Rajiv ranjan Sinha has taken responsibility to prepare a PPT. presentation.

5.) Media partnership/Advocacy: - To establish partnership with media it is decided that every member organization will give a case study by 30th September. Indramani sahu and Goutam Sagar have taken the responsibility to fine tune the case studies and finalize a final draft of case studies. Ajay Kumar will talk with the media person to publish the case studies in daily newspaper or a press conference will be done during capacity building training at state level.

6.) Criteria for new groups to be added in FEM Jharkhand.

Since few new groups are interested to be part of FEM Jharkhand so the criteria for being member of FEM Jharkhand discussed and the following criteria decided:-
